## Ohio Vendor's License Fee to Increase Effective April 9, 2025

Logan County, OH – The Ohio Department of Taxation has announced that, following the passage of House Bill 366, the one-time fee for applying for a new vendor's license will increase from \$25 to \$50, effective April 9, 2025.

This \$25 increase will support the Organized Crime Commission Fund, which reimburses political subdivisions for expenses incurred when their law enforcement officers participate in an organized crime task force (ORC 177.011).

## Who Is Affected?

This fee applies to businesses applying for either type of new vendor's license:

Vendor's License – Required for businesses selling tangible goods or services in Ohio. This license is issued by the county auditor where the business is based.

Transient Vendor License – Required for businesses selling goods or services temporarily at events like fairs, markets, or festivals. This license is obtained through the Ohio Business Gateway.
